Public infrastructure - healthcare, education, housing, utilities, and social services for all

Workers' ownership of the means of production, e.g. worker co-ops

Mutual aid networks

Reproductive freedom and queer & trans liberation

Disability justice

Absence of police, prisons, and other manifestations of the carceral state

Other Definitions of Socialism?

Peter H. Clark, 1829-1925

The first explicit Black socialist in America

In his biography, it is noted that resentment grew against Black workers who were striking for better wages during Reconstruction

These workers faced many blockades - like white tradesmen who unionized to block them

"His political destiny was inextricably linked to the progress of African Americans collectively"

Never achieved political office, but his commitment to the ideology was clear
